



## Step 1:

### Add a high school grade level:

1. *Select the School that you attended for that grade level*
2. *Select the appropriate Academic Year*
3. *Click the green check mark to continue*

### 2. Add a high school Course:

1. Start by entering the course title
2. Once you start typing you will select the correct course from the drop down menu

### 3. Select the course type:

1. Standard level
2. AP
3. Honors

### 4. Enter the grade earned for each term

1. If completed - Select letter grade
2. Select in progress if you are currently taking class
3. Select Planned - If you will take class in the future.

### 5. Click 'Add Grade Level' and repeat steps 1-4
